- ▶ Commonwealth funded internships for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students and graduates
- ▶ Over 200 Aurora host organisations based in major cities, as well as regional and remote locations across Australia
- ▶ Funding covers: \$900 per week living expenses and up to \$3,800 incl. GST for travel expenses
- ▶ 4 to 6 week Winter (June - October) & Summer (November - May) placements
- ▶ Over 700 alumni employed and over 900 jobs created in the sector
